

Requirements for submission of an Amendment

- 1. 3 hard copies of the following "in the same order and in 3 separate packages":
 - a. Cover letter including the submitted documents for amendment with their versions and dates
 - b. Signed and dated amendment application form
 - c. Previously submitted application form
 - d. Detailed progress report including :
 - Enrollment of subjects: gender and age in comparison with targeted subjects.
 - Number of subjects withdrawn and reasons for such withdrawal
 - Adverse events, management and outcome (Cumulative and type for the previous period since the last review)
 - Results, if available
 - e. Documents submitted for amendment as following:
 - New amended version of the document
 - Old "currently approved" version of the document
 - Table of summary of changes or track changed version

NB: If the consent form is more than 5 pages, please submit an additional summary for consent form guided by REC consent form template in no more than 3 pages.

- f. Current REC approval letter.
- 2. 1 CD including all above documents.
- 3. Application fees:
